

A diaper drive is a great way to help address diaper need in your community!

During a diaper drive, diapers, wipes, and donations are collected and then delivered to a local diaper bank.

Drives can be as simple as placing a box for donations at school or work or it could be a large-scale themed event with volunteers!

- Grocery stores




# Event Admission:

One of the best ways to spread the word about your diaper drive is for you and your team to use social media!

#### **INSTAGRAM:**

- Share photos of your flyer, donations, team, and more!
- Use hashtags to draw attention to your post- #DiaperNeed
- Tag the diaper collection sites with the location tool
- Tag @centraljerseydiaperbank in your posts along with others who are involved
- Use Instagram Live to capture your diaper drive day or when you're setting up





# Diaper Need in the United States

# What is Diaper Need?

Diaper need is the lack of a sufficient amount of diapers to keep a baby clean, dry, and healthy.

Babies require up to 12 diapers a day, toddlers about eight.

# The Numbers

5.2 million BABIES AND TODDLERS LIVE IN POOR OR LOW-INCOME FAMILIES.

\* Diapers are as essential to a child's basic needs as food and shelter.


Yet, state and national safety net programs do not recognize diapers as a basic need.

#### THE CONSEQUENCES OF DIAPER NEED

- Babies who remain too long in a soiled diaper are exposed to potential health risks.
- Most child care centers, even free and subsidized facilities, require parents to provide a day's supply of disposable diapers.
- Many parents cannot go to work or school if they can't leave their babies at child care.



A recent study conducted by NDBN and Huggies® found that parents who struggled with diaper need missed an average of four days of work in a month.<sup>1</sup>

# What is a Diaper Bank?

A diaper bank is a nonprofit group that collects, stores, and distributes free diapers to homeless shelters, food pantries, family service agencies and faith-based organizations. Some are direct service as well.

#### HOW DIAPER BANKS FUNCTION

- Funds donated to diaper banks enable the direct purchase of diapers through innovative, cost saving programs
- Diaper drives by individuals, communities, and businesses collect diapers to donate to local programs
- Volunteers and employees repackage diapers and perform other essential duties

## THE DIAPER GAP

- Households experiencing diaper need are an average of 19 diapers short a month.
- More than a quarter of families in diaper need rely on diaper banks to help fill that gap.<sup>1</sup>
